In 2013 the HSE handed over governance of first aid provision to Ofqual and the onus of training programme selection to the employer. This has subsequently freed employers from the strictures of the traditional HSE Workplace First Aid Courses and allows them to select which course is most suitable for their workplace and working environment.

Aims

- To assess delegate knowledge through continuous practical observation rather than formal written examinations.

8hr Emergency First Aid at Work + Forestry First Aid EFAW+F – Level 3 Award

Target Group: Forestry workers or those working outdoors within the agricultural industry

Prior Learning: None

Introduction: Different to standard Workplace First Aid courses, our EFAW+F courses are designed to provide outdoor incident management skills. Training is predominantly outdoors and of a practical nature, tailored to meet the needs of the participant often working in outdoor clothing with PPE and on various terrains.

Content: This 8-hour course looks at the following topics; roles & responsibilities of a First Aider working outdoors, adult & child specific treatments, dealing with collapse (with and without breathing), drowning, choking, bleeding, shock, major illnesses, torso and limb injuries, environmental effects, heat and cold injuries, using first aid kit, outdoor specific scenarios, outdoor incident management and looking after a casualty for a protracted period.



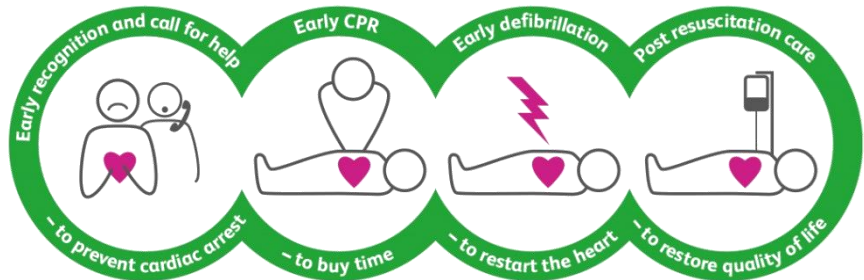
Description: This Ofqual regulated qualification introduces the techniques, skills and decisions that will be needed by the employees working perhaps hours from assistance, in the British Isles. The skills and knowledge will be taught in a realistic outdoor context. This qualification satisfies the statutory HSE obligations of an employer who has identified the need for a single day first aid course in their first aid needs assessment.

Additional Certification: As part of our Public Courses, we deliver the Outdoor First Aid Course in parallel to the Emergency Paediatric First Aid (PFA) content. We are therefore able to assess

both courses simultaneously, which means that delegates are able to gain certification in Emergency Paediatric First Aid at the same time! This course also covers and can be additionally certificated for *1-day Outdoor First Aid, Emergency Action.*

Cost

These courses can be delivered as either Open Courses (open to members of the public) or as Bespoke Courses (delivered to a specific client group with content tailored to participant needs).
