Scope and Content

Awareness of First Aid for Mental Health - 4hr

Cost - £105pp

Course Title - Level 1 Award in Awareness of First Aid for Mental Health - 4hr (FAMHA)

Target Group - This course is suitable for everyone within a workplace keen to develop a positive mental health culture as it provides learners with the knowledge to identify suspected mental health conditions as well as the skills to start a conversation and be able to signpost a person towards professional help.



RQF Regulation & Accreditation - This qualification is regulated in the UK by First Aid Awards. FAA are an Awarding organisation regulated by OfQual and SQA Accreditation. The qualification sits on the Regulated Qualifications Framework and the Scottish Credit and Qualifications Framework (SCQF).

Prior Learning - None

Description - This 4-hour qualification provides delegates with the knowledge to recognise a range of mental health conditions, how to start a supportive conversation and when and how to signpost a person to seek appropriate professional help. Learners will know how to recognise and manage stress. Delegates will not diagnose or treat mental health conditions as this can only be carried out by healthcare professionals but will gain the knowledge to identify when a person may have a condition and know where they can go to get help.

Specific content includes - A range of subjects are covered including; What is First Aid for Mental Health?, Identifying mental health conditions, Providing advice and starting a conversation, Stress, Mental health conditions.

First Aid for Mental Health – 6hr



Course Title - Level 2 Award in First Aid for Mental Health - 6hr (FAMH)

Target Group - This 1-day course covers the content of the Level 1 course but also expands on the effects of drugs and alcohol, incorporates the First Aid for Mental Health Action Plan and covers ways in which a positive mental health culture can be supported within a workplace.

RQF Regulation & Accreditation - This qualification is regulated in the UK by First Aid Awards. FAA are an Awarding organisation regulated by OfQual and SQA Accreditation. The qualification sits on the Regulated Qualifications Framework and the Scottish Credit and Qualifications Framework (SCQF).

Prior Learning - None

Description - This 6-hour qualification provides delegates with the knowledge to recognise a range of mental health conditions, how to start a supportive conversation and when and how to signpost a person to seek appropriate professional help. delegates will know how to recognise and manage stress and understand the impact of substance abuse. They will learn about the first aid action plan for mental health, be able to put it in place and know how to implement a positive mental health culture in the workplace. It covers the content of both the Level 1 and Level 2 Qualifications but is aimed at Trainer/ Assessors and/or supervisor level employees within the workplace. Cost
