In 2013 the HSE handed over governance of first aid provision to OfQual and the onus of training programme selection to the employer. This has subsequently freed employers from the strictures of the traditional HSE Workplace First Aid Courses, allowing you to select which course is most suitable for your workplace and working environment.

Aims

- To develop knowledge and understanding of First Aid and Emergency Response Procedures.
- To empower delegates with the confidence to assess and react to an incident within their training.
- To develop skills that are relevant to their workplace and which can be adapted to meet different circumstances and environments.
- To encourage further study and promote the value of continuing professional development.

16hr Outdoor First Aid - L3 (Incl. FA for Horticulture & Agriculture)

Target Group: People venturing outside either for work or pleasure to remote settings where help and assistance can be protracted.

Prior Learning: None

Introduction: Different to Workplace First Aid courses, our Outdoor First Aid courses are designed to provide outdoor incident management skills. Training is predominantly outdoors and of a practical nature, tailored to meet the needs of the participant often working in outdoor clothing with PPE and on various terrains.

Content: This 16-hour course looks at the following topics; roles & responsibilities of an Outdoor First Aider, adult & child specific treatments, dealing with collapse (with and without breathing),



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drowning, choking, bleeding, shock, major illnesses, torso and limb injuries, environmental effects, heat and cold injuries, using first aid kit, outdoor specific scenarios, outdoor incident management and looking after a casualty for more than 10 minutes.



Description: This course introduces the techniques, skills and confidence that will be needed to deal with an incident when venturing outside in the British Isles where assistance is more than a few minutes away. This qualification indicates an individual can undertake the role of Outdoor First Aider in more rural and remote areas.

The need for an Outdoor First Aider might have been identified by a Workplace First Aid Needs Assessment and can be relied upon by employers to satisfy the due diligence requirements of the HSE for first aid training providers. Successful completion of the course will result in knowledge and skills that have been identified by the Institute for Outdoor Learning First Aid Training Framework for the safe, effective and prompt treatment of injuries and illness, with the management of incidents in the outdoors.

The course will be delivered in a realistic outdoor context and will satisfy the first aid requirements for instructors with most of the outdoor industry National Governing Bodies.

Additional Certification: As part of the our Public Courses, we deliver the Outdoor First Aid Course in parallel to the Forest Schools First Aid (FSFA) course and assessment path which includes the Paediatric First Aid (PFA) content. We are therefore able to assess both courses simultaneously, which means that delegates are able to gain certification in Paediatric First Aid at the same time! This course also covers and can be additionally certificated for Forest Schools First Aid, First Aid at Work – Requalification, Emergency First Aid at Work and Forestry First Aid (+F).

Cost

These courses can be delivered as either Public Courses (open to members of the public) or as Bespoke Courses (delivered to a specific client group with content tailored to participant needs).



Open/ Public Courses: £155pp &
